However if the article is only available online (for example there are no page numbers) reference as below. AUTHOR(S) (date) Title of article. Title of journal. [Online] Vol. no. To be made up of: Authors. Year of publication (in round brackets). Title of article (in single quotation marks). Title of journal (in italics and capitalise first letter of each word in title, except for linking words such as and, of, the, for).

The following format should be used when referencing electronic journal articles: Surname, Initials. (Year) Title of article. Title of journal, Vol no (issue no), pp. page nos [Online]. Available from: website address. [Accessed date viewed]. The [accessed date] is included as often links to Web-based resources can change.

'Harvard referencing' is an umbrella term for any referencing style that uses the author name and year of publication within the text to indicate where you have inserted a source. This author-date system appeals to both authors and readers of academic work.
